



# **TLILIC0005 Licence to Operate a Boom-type Elevating Work Platform (boom length 11m or more) (2-Day Course)**



This two-day course introduces participants to work at height as well as both the theoretical and practical elements of safely operating a motorized elevated work platform.

The course covers subjects such as:

## **LEARNING MODULES:**

- EWP safety awareness
- Work at height with a Harnesses and other personal protective equipment
- Hazard identification, Risk Assessment, Hazard Controls Measures
- Pre and post operational checks
- EWP orientation
- Australian standards
- EWP orientation (ground controls)
- EWP orientation platform controls
- EWP operation (emergency controls from the ground)
- Emergency controls from the platform

At the successful completion of this course, student will receive a Statement of Attainment and the High Risk Work License\* to Operate a Boom-type Elevating Work Platform (Boom length 11m or more) by WorkSafe WA.

(\* Raines Resources will only submit student's WorkSafe application and issue SOA after full payment is received)



### **TRAINING DETAILS:**

**Start Time:** 8:00 am until 4 pm (Please arrive 15 minutes earlier for registration and ID checked)

**Entry Requirement:** At least 18 years of age.

**Literacy:** Participants must have a basic level of English proficiency (written and verbal communication)

**Numeracy** Participants require the knowledge of how to use a calculator

**Delivery:** Face to Face training and assessment in a simulated workplace environment

**Payment Mode:** Cash, credit card, direct funds transfer with a bank receipt or a company purchase order refer to our finance policy for further details

**What to bring: 1 Photo ID and 1 Secondary ID, Current WorkSafe Licence Card (if any)**

(e.g. Driver's Licence, Passport (current or expired being no more than 2 years from the expiry date), WA proof of age card or other Australian Government issued ID card with photo) **AND** (e.g. Medicare Card, current credit card or ATM card, telephone, gas, electricity account not more than 12 months old)

**Clothing:** Long sleeve shirt, long pants and safety boots

### **ASSESSMENT COMPONENTS:**

- Theory information and assessment
- Calculations
- Practical operation of an EWP

All students must pass the three assessment components to be able to receive a Statement of Attainment (SOA)
